

Public Safety Committee - August 18, 2021

The Public Safety Committee met on Wednesday, August 18, 2021, at 4:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

A motion was made by Bladt and seconded by Rudolph to approve the agenda. The motion carried unanimously.

Sergeant Tim Pederson discussed the K-9 program and availability of a two-and-a-half-year-old K-9 dog from the Iowa State Patrol. The K-9 dog is fully trained in narcotics, tracking and evidence recovery. The cost would be \$7,000 for the dog and \$1,000 for training with Sergeant Pederson.

A motion was made by Rudolph and seconded by Bladt to present and recommend to council, the purchase of the K-9 dog. The motion carried unanimously.
